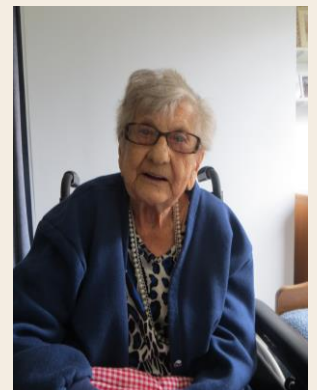
Alma Stowe, The Cat Lover!
