About Dinsdale Personal Care

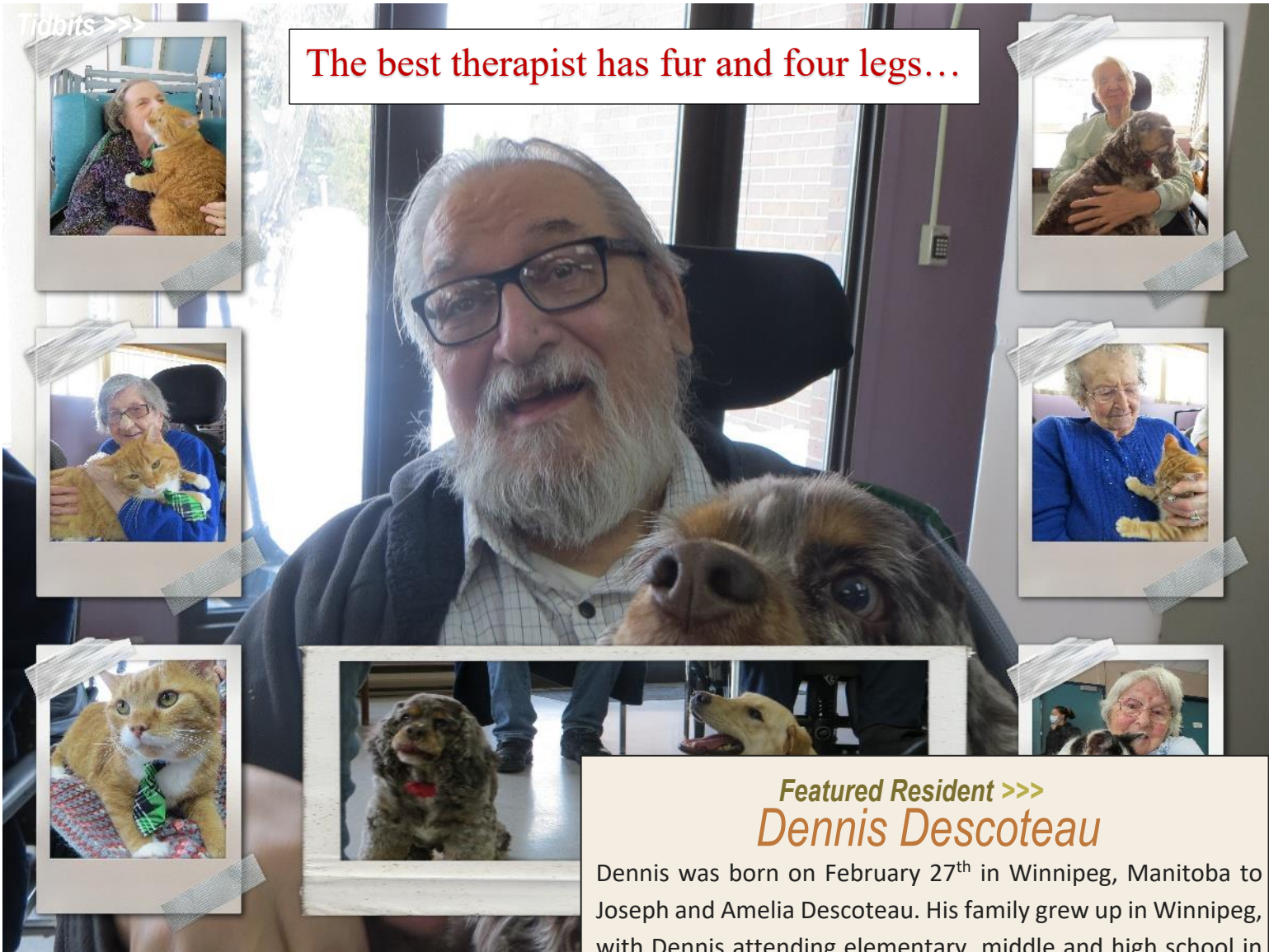
